The following must be completed between August 1, 2010 and June 20, 2011 to qualify for the 2011 Florida trip.

**Required:**

1. Put your five hours of fundraising in towards the troop.
2. Have a full class A uniform (shirt, long pants & belt OR shirt, shorts, scout socks & belt).
3. Two or more hours of community service.
4. Earn one Eagle-required merit badge (unless you are an Eagle Scout, in which case, this requirement is waived)

**Do nine of the following:**

1. Earn the Polar Bear Award.
2. Advance one rank.
3. Earn one additional merit badge.
4. Help two younger scouts reach Tenderfoot, 2<sup>nd</sup> Class, or 1<sup>st</sup> Class.
5. Attend four or more Troop 68 campouts between October 2010 and May 2011.
6. Serve **Actively** in an elected position for six months.
7. Turn 2011 Pipestone wood in by June 20<sup>th</sup> 2011
8. Serve as a den chief for six months with Pack 68.
9. Help lead a program at a troop meeting.
10. Community service hours (3 hrs. over and above the 2 hrs. required).
11. Attend and earn your trained certification from the Troop.
12. Attend a work day at the garage (for clean-up).
13. Star or Life scouts---assist on a Webelos campout.
14. Attend Scout Sunday.
15. Assist on an Eagle Scout project.
16. Scoutmaster approved project.
17. Enter in the Church of the Cross chili cook off on September 18, 2010.
18. Attend one religious service at a church , Synagogue, or mosque of your choice ( Scout Sunday excluded-Bring a bulletin from the service you attended to the Scoutmaster)

**As a Patrol, do one of the following.** Must have three or more patrol members present):

1. Earn the National Baden Powell Patrol Award.
2. Have one over night campout (not during scheduled troop campouts).
3. As a patrol , earn a merit badge.
4. Do two or more hours of community service. (not to include other hours.)
5. Sign up with the Advancement Coordinator to come early and help set-up for a Court of Honor.
